# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE)

The JAE is conducted annually by the Ministry of Education (MOE) to allow holders of GCE O-Level certificate to apply for admission to courses offered by the Junior Colleges (JCs), Millennia Institute (MI), Polytechnics and Institute of Technical Education (ITE).



# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE)

All students successfully admitted to a school through the Direct School Admission-JC (**DSAJC**) Exercise / Polytechnic Early Admissions Exercise (**Poly EAE**) / ITE Early Admissions Exercise (**ITE EAE**) will not be able to participate in JAE.

Students will be informed of the school they have been admitted to under the **DSA-JC/Poly EAE/ITE EAE** together with the release of the GCE 'O' Level Examination results.

Unsuccessful DSA-JC/Poly EAE/ITE EAE students will be able to participate in JAE and they will receive JAE Form A containing courses that they are eligible to apply for.



# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE)

**Form A** contains the JAE PIN, GCE 'O' Level Examination results, Aggregate scores and the Eligible Courses of each student.

**Form J** shows the list of Nitec courses a student is eligible to apply for based on his/her GCE 'O' Level examination results. GCE 'O' students receiving the JAE Form A may also apply for Nitec courses.



# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE)

All applications for courses must be submitted online through the JAE-Internet System (**JAE-IS**). The **JAE-IS** is accessible through the JAE website at [www.moe.gov.sg/jae](http://www.moe.gov.sg/jae)

You are required to key in your NRIC / FIN and **SingPass** or **JAE PIN** to gain access to the JAE-Internet System (**JAE-IS**). **JAE PIN is found in Form A.**

You are advised to make full use of the **12 choices**, where applicable.



# JOINT ADMISSION EXERCISE (JAE)

During the JAE registration period, students who are eligible for JAE can also **download a copy of the Form A** from **JAE Internet System (JAE-IS)** for safe keeping.

Upon successful submission of their choices, the **verification slip** will be sent to the email address provided by the student during registration.



# JOINT ADMISSION EXERCISE (JAE)

The JAE 2023 registration will be held over a period of **6** calendar days, starting from

**3.00 pm on 12 January 2023** to

**4.00 pm on 17 January 2023.**

During the JAE registration period, students can seek assistance using the online JAE Request Form found at [www.moe.gov.sg/jaerequestform](http://www.moe.gov.sg/jaerequestform).

Please note that Library will be opened for JAE registration strictly by appointment (**Except 12 – 1pm Lunch**) through FTs.

# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE) – JCs and MI

JCs and MI offer a variety of subjects and different subject combinations. They may also set their **own school-based criteria** for subjects offered, based on professional and student-centric considerations.

Posting to an Arts, Science or Commerce course does not guarantee that students will be able to offer their preferred subject combinations. **Students should check the website of the respective JCs and MI for more details on the subject combinations offered in the Arts, Science and Commerce courses and school-based criteria for subjects offered.**





## JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE) – Poly/ITE courses

Beyond academic requirements, students should note that some polytechnic/ ITE courses may require students **to meet non-academic requirements**, such as passing of medical examinations, in order to comply with industry requirements.

These requirements can also be found in the JAE information booklet and **students are advised to take these requirements into account when making their choices.**



# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE)

In the event that you are not posted, please take part in the combined poly/ITE JAE appeals and consider a range of courses and institutions, including Higher Nitec courses at ITE.

Do consider accepting your “alternative posting” should you receive one at the end of JAE appeals.



# JOINT ADMISSIONS EXERCISE (JAE)

Accepting the “alternative posting” helps students to secure a place in a post-secondary education institution (PSEI); Students who wish to appeal for a transfer to another course or institution should approach the institution directly.



# Direct School Admission - JCs

Students who had **accepted** offers through the 2022 Direct School Admission – Junior Colleges (DSA-JC) **will be admitted** to their chosen JC if they have **met the eligibility criteria** for admission based on their GCE O-Level examination results.

Students admitted to a JC through DSA-JC **will not be eligible** to participate in the JAE.

Students who do not meet the JC admission criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for courses which they are eligible for. More details on DSA-JC can be found at [www.moe.gov.sg/dsa-jc](http://www.moe.gov.sg/dsa-jc).



# JOINT ADMISSION EXERCISE (JAE)

The posting results of the JAE application will be released on **Thursday, 2 February 2023** through the following modes:

- Short Message Service (SMS) to the Singapore mobile number provided by the applicant during registration
- JAE-IS, accessible through the JAE website



# JC transfers after JAE

Students who wish to appeal for a JC transfer on other grounds may submit their appeals to JCs directly but they are likely to be unsuccessful if they have not met that JC's course COP in this year's JAE or do not present extenuating circumstances.

Students successfully allocated a school via DSA-JC will not be allowed to transfer to another JC. They are expected to honour their commitment to the DSA-JC schools.



# APPEAL FOR REVIEW OF RESULTS

All appeals must be submitted through the school.

A fee will be charged for an appeal to review the result for each subject.

Deadline : **Wednesday, 18 January 2023**

# Polytechnic Foundation Programmes (PFP)

PFP – eligible students will be issued a **Form 'P'**

Your password can be found in **Form 'P'**.

# Polytechnic Foundation Programmes (PFP)

Applications for the PFP will be open from **2.00 pm on Thursday, 12 January 2023** until **4.00pm on Tuesday, 17 January 2023**. The PFP posting results will be released at **2.00pm on Thursday, 26 January 2023** through the PFP website.

Students must indicate their decision to **accept/reject/appeal** in the PFP Portal by **4.00pm on Tuesday, 31 January 2023**.

# Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

Secondary 5 Normal (Academic) students who are newly eligible after taking into account their O-Level examination results should submit their DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at

[www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses](http://www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses).

The final application phase for the DPP will open from **12.01am on Thursday, 12 January 2023 to 11.59pm on Tuesday, 17 January 2023.**

# Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

The DPP posting results for applications made under the final application phase will be released **at 9.00am on Thursday, 19 January 2023** through the DPP application portal.

Upon receiving their DPP posting results, students will have to indicate in the online system whether they are **accepting/rejecting/appealing** their DPP offers **by Wednesday, 25 January 2023**.

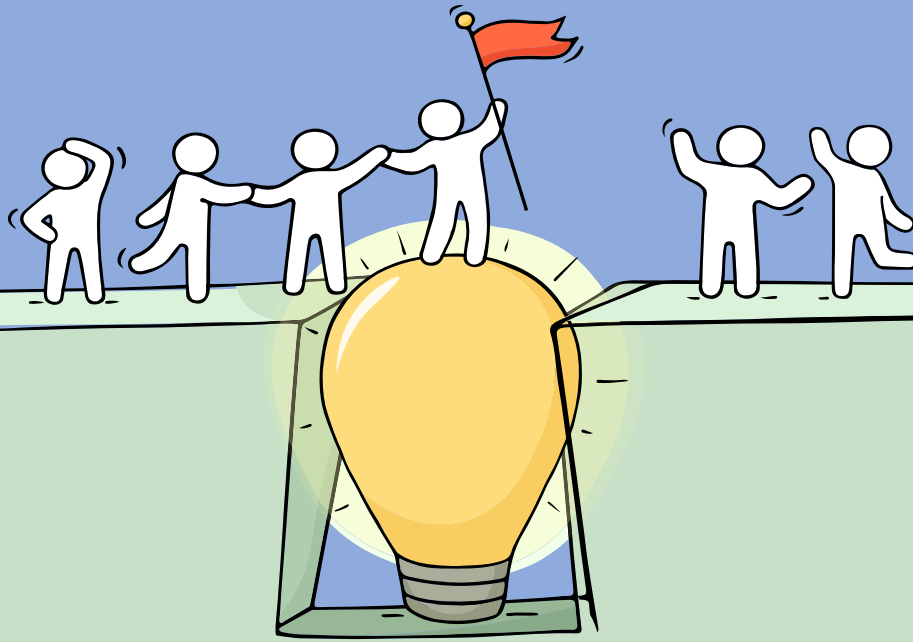
## Successful PFP and/or DPP Applicants

Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase should report to ITE on **Wednesday, 25 January 2023**, upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.

The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be **on Friday, 27 January 2023**. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.

Students who accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but have now decided to take up a PFP offer will need to apply to ITE to withdraw from the DPP first, before they are able to take up the PFP offer.

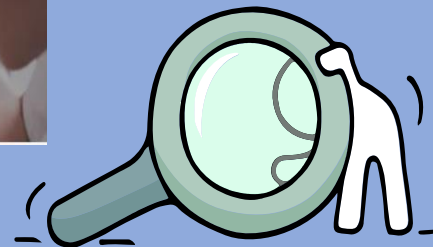
