Did You Know?

We are the first junior college to offer the AEP, an enriched art programme for artistically talented students, in 1985. With 113 students across 6 levels, we now host the largest AEP. From 2016, NJC became the first AEP Centre to offer the Programme to external secondary students. Lessons are conducted from 3pm to 6pm every Tuesday afternoon for lower secondary. Lessons for upper secondary will be on every Thursday afternoon.

What Do We Offer?

Our programme covers exciting and comprehensive studio and theoretical studies in art. Our multidisciplinary studio programme challenges students to create art and express themselves using multiple mediums and different technologies. Students will also be able to critically appraise and appreciate art through learning about Western and Southeast Asian art history, art theory and criticism. In addition, students will:

- be part of a larger 600-strong AEP community, interacting through combined workshops and events
- exhibit their works in school as well as national platforms
- participate in authentic learning experiences at local and overseas immersion learning journeys, museums, and with artists and other industry practitioners
