Start Right – 3 ‘A’s

- **A**ttitude
- **A**ttendance
- **A**pppearance





Attitude

- Students must be exemplary in their conduct and demonstrate the school values of Integrity, Compassion, Resilience, Discipline and Respect at all times.

Attitude

- Students must be polite and mindful of their manners at all times. They must greet teaching staff, non-teaching staff and visitors upon meeting them.
- Students must respect and obey school authorities – e.g. Principal, teachers, student leaders, and non-teaching staff at all times.



Attitude



- Students must use their time efficiently and effectively during relief periods or when the teacher is absent from the class. They must remain at their seats to :
 - i) complete the work given, if any
 - ii) do their own silent reading
 - iii) do their revision
- They should not spend the time sleeping or chatting with classmates.
- Engaging in discussions or peer tutoring is also not allowed.

Attendance



- Every student is expected to be punctual for school. Students must be present in their classes for attendance taking by the following times:
Mon: 8.50 am
Tue – Fri : 8.00 am
- Students who arrive early in school are to proceed to the classroom for the silent reading programme.

Attendance



- Every student must seek permission from the Principal, Vice-Principals or Heads of Department if he/she needs to leave the school premises during school hours.
- The student will have to inform his/her Form Teacher and complete a permission slip which can be obtained from the General Office.
- Students who leave school during school hours should be accompanied by their parents/guardians for their own safety.



Attendance

- Students who are exempted from any subject are to remain in their classrooms and do their own work.



Appearance

- Students must adhere to the prescribed rules and regulations on school attire that can be found in the GESS handbook and GESS Portal.

Appearance

- Every student will have to report to school in **full uniform with school tie** every Monday, regardless of whether there is PE lesson on that day.
- On other days, students can wear **half uniform** (with PE T-shirt only) to school if they have PE lesson on that day. They may change to school based T-shirts after PE but they must be in half uniform.
- Fridays are **dress-down** days so students may wear school based T-shirts. However, they will need to ensure that it is half uniform.
- Students are to put on their name tag for all the student attire.
- **GESS PE T-shirt** must be worn during PE lessons. Other school based T-shirts are not allowed.
