# JOINT INTAKE EXERCISE (JIE)

Joint Intake Exercise 'N' (JIE 'N') for the **2-year Nitec Courses**

The JIE 'N' is conducted to enable GCE 'N' (Technical) / GCE 'N' (Academic) / GCE 'O' Level holders to apply for the **2-year National ITE Certificate (Nitec)** courses conducted by Institute of Technical Education (ITE).

GCE 'N' Technical/ GCE 'N' (Academic) /GCE 'O' Level holders can choose to take up course under **Full-Time Education** or **Traineeship**.



# JOINT INTAKE EXERCISE (JIE)

## Joint Intake Exercise 'H' (JIE 'H') for Higher Nitec Courses under Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

The JIE 'H' is conducted to enable GCE 'N' (Academic) holders with the **relevant pre-requisites** to apply for the Higher National ITE Certificate (*Higher Nitec*) courses conducted by ITE under Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP).

Eligible GCE 'N' (Academic) Level holders may apply for *Higher Nitec* courses under both the JIE 'H' and *Nitec* courses under the JIE 'N' intake exercises. However, you are offered a *Higher Nitec* course under the JIE 'H', you will not be offered a *Nitec* course under the JIE 'N'.

The JIE registration will be held over a period of **5** calendar days, starting from

**2.30pm on 19 Dec 2019 to 5pm on 23 Dec 2019.**

Students can access the computer system and printer in the Aroozoo Library to complete their JIE on

**20 Dec and 23 Dec, 9am - 12pm.**

A set of instructions on the ITE application process is also made available in the Aroozoo Library.

# APPEAL FOR REVIEW OF RESULTS

The fee for an appeal to review the result of any subject is \$112.35 per subject (inclusive of 7% GST)

Students who do not have strong grounds should be discouraged from submitting an appeal

# Application to ITE

- Main Phase ends on **23 Dec 2019**
- Late applications will still be accepted by ITE via two additional phases
  - Appeal Phase/Late Application –  
**3 Jan 2020 to 7 Jan 2020**
  - Final Top-Up Phase –  
1<sup>st</sup> Top-up Phrase Application  
**15 Jan to 23 Jan 2020**  
2<sup>nd</sup> Top-up Phrase Application  
**29 Jan to 10 Feb 2020**



# Key Pointers for Students on ITE's Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) for Admission to *Nitec* Courses

Secondary



8 things you should know



ITE

All N(T) students and N(A) students (who are not progressing to 5N(A) or repeating 4N(A)) are eligible for JIE.

Keen competition for *Nitec* courses, so use all 12 choices!

Participation in Main Phase is key to secure a place in ITE!

If you are applying for Traineeship, make sure you apply in Main Phase to avoid missing a place!

If you are unsuccessful in EAE, make sure you apply in Main Phase to avoid missing a place!

If you have received an additional letter, then you are eligible for the 3-year *Nitec* Programme (eNFP).

If you are eligible for eNFP, make sure you apply for the 2-year *Nitec* first before applying for eNFP!

Additional eNFP year helps to improve literacy and numeracy skills!
