

MOE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME (MOE FAS)

The Ministry of Education provides financial assistance to Singaporean students in Government and Government-Aided Schools who need financial assistance for their studies.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Student is a Singapore citizen enrolled in a Government or Government-aided school and meets either one of the following criteria:

a. Gross household income (GHI) as at the time of application does not exceed \$3,000 per month; or

b. Household per capita income (*PCI) as at the time of application does not exceed \$750 per month. *PCI = GHI / No. of household members

HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS

1. Household members include the student, his/her parents, and unmarried siblings of the student, **regardless** of the address.

2. Grandparents and other dependants living at the same address may be included on a case-bycase basis. They include:

a. Relatives who are old or sick and are unemployed and dependent on the family; and

b. Child dependant (where the family is the legal guardian).

Item	Benefits
School Fees	Full subsidy of \$5.00 per month
Standard Miscellaneous Fees	Full subsidy of \$10.00 per month
Textbooks	Free textbooks
School Attire	 2 sets of uniforms (school uniform vendor Bibi and Baba Pte Ltd) 2 sets of PE attire, a pair of shoes and 2 pairs of socks (available at school's bookshop) Please refer to school's website for dates of collection.
School Meals Subsidy*	\$3.80 per meal for 10 meals per school week Students are required to bring along their School Smart Card (SSC) to the School's General Office for a one-time registration.
Public Transport Subsidy^	 \$20 transport subsidy per month from month of approval, up to \$240 per annum for students taking public transport Student must produce School Smart Card to redeem the transport e-voucher at any Transit Link Ticket Offices located at selected stations or through the Transit Link Add Value Machines from 28th of the current month to 10th of the next month.

Benefits of MOE FAS:

Aff the FAS application approval is not from January, the transport subsidy will be pro-rated accordingly from the month after your application is approved to December of the same year.



Application can be submitted through either Online form or Hardcopy form:

a) Online form (eFAS) at https://go.gov.sg/moe-efas

Singpass is required for online submission. Supporting documents (e.g. pay slips, CPF statements etc) in softcopy should be prepared in advance for uploading when submitting the application via eFAS.

b) Hardcopy form

For new applicant, student/parent/guardian can get a hardcopy of the application form from the General Office. The softcopy is also available in the attachment

Completed application form together with necessary supporting documents are to be submitted to the General Office through your child\ward.

Application via hardcopy form is required for:

- families with other dependents (Great grandparents, Aunties/Uncles, Cousins and others)
- family with more than 5 children in GGAS
- family with more than 4 unmarried children not in GGAS
- family with more than 3 grandparents in the household

ComCare recipient need not submit the application for MOE FAS as MOE FAS will be autogranted to ComCare beneficiaries in Government and Government-Aided Schools (GGAS).

Once the application is approved, the school will make arrangement for your child to collect the textbooks and uniform.

Other Information
