Common FAQs

First Day of School Programme

• What is the programme for the first day of school? What does my child need to bring? What time will he/she be dismissed?

• Can I accompany my child to school and observe him/her during morning assembly?

Parents can accompany their child to school on the first day but will not be allowed to stay in school to observe your child. Rest assured that the Form Teachers will ensure the well-being of your child. We seek parents' understanding for the safety of everyone.

• Can I drive the car into the school to drop my child?

Yes. Parents can drop off their children at the foyer. Please be reminded that you cannot make a right turn at the school exit gate after 6.45am for ease of traffic flow.

• What is the attire for the first day of school?

School uniform with white short / green skirt. For students who did not manage to purchase the school attire, they can report to school in their primary school attire until they have purchased the uniform.

• What is the programme for Secondary 1 GESS Camp? What are the dismissal timings?

The school will also issue the Sec 1 students with \$6.00 worth of food voucher (for two days) for them to use during the duration of the GESS Camp.

Application for Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS)

• How do I know if I am eligible for FAS?

Eligibility Criteria

1) Gross Household Income \$3000 or below OR

2) Per Capita Income \$750 or below (Per Capita Income = Total Household Income / Number of Household Members)

If you marginally miss the criteria, you can still apply for School FAS, which will provide benefits similar to that of MOE FAS.

Mother Tongue Languages Matters

• Can I apply for exemption from MTL for my child?

The Mother Tongue Language (MTL) policy requires all students (including foreign students) to study MTL as it is an entry requirement to junior colleges and local universities. Unless supported with medical documents issued by a medical practitioner that clearly support exemption from MTL, all students are to study MTL with the only exception being those students who have been granted exemption from MTL during PSLE.

• Can I appeal for my child to study Higher Mother Tongue at the end of Sec 1?

Criteria for studying Higher MT is to score at least 75% for the subject and 70% overall for all subjects. Students who meet these criteria and are interested to study Higher MT will be considered and approval is subject to school's decision.
